Zonta ABC accepts applications from 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations and funds small projects that are consistent with the tenants of Zonta. Grants range between \$50 and \$2,000. Decisions are made by the Board of the Zonta ABC Foundation and are not negotiable. Each organization granted funds should consider them as one-time-only funds, as there are no assurances for further funding. Annual reports of the funds expended, program beneficiaries, and project activities will be required, if funded.

Requests for funds should include the following typed, in this order with each section labeled.

- A. Completed cover sheet.
- B. Description of project (*Note: Sections B-D are limited to three pages total.*):
 1. How will your organization use any funds granted by Zonta ABC Foundation?
 2. How much are you requesting?
 3. How does your request support Zonta's mission statement?
 4. What problem will your project solve?
 5. Tell us about the women this project will serve.
 6. Do you expect anyone other than women to benefit? If so, please explain.
 7. How many women will your project benefit between June 30 and May 30 of the funding year if the Zonta ABC Foundation grants your organization the entire amount of funding requested?

C. Information regarding your agency:

1. Background, including when formed, mission statement, affiliations (United Way, religious organizations, etc.), purpose, population served, list of trustees and officers.

D. List any other requests for funding for this project and amount:
